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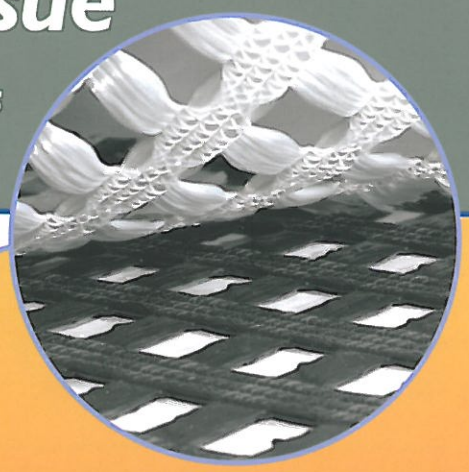

Dornbirn Man-made Fibers celebrates its 54th edition

CELEBRATING its 54th edition, the *Dornbirn Man-made Fibers Congress* will take place this year in Dornbirn, Austria (16–18 September 2015).

However, the event will be the first under the supervision of Friedrich Weninger, who succeeded Heinz Kmonicek as the Manager and Chairman of the Programme Committee in December 2014. Weninger says he plans to develop the event “as a generator of ideas, and the basis for networking in the interest of the global fibre industry and its downstream manufacturing stages”. He also wants to place a greater emphasis on the cooperation between the industry, universities, technical colleges and trade associations.

This year the event will comprise more than 100 specialized presentations grouped within several themes:

- fibre and filament innovations, including polymers/biopolymers;
- functionalization and adaptation of fibres and their surfaces;
- nonwovens, in particular those for applications in filtration;
- environment and health;
- advanced fibres and processing technologies.

The organizer, the Vienna-based Austrian Man-Made Fibers Institute (Austrian-MFI), anticipates more than 800 participants.

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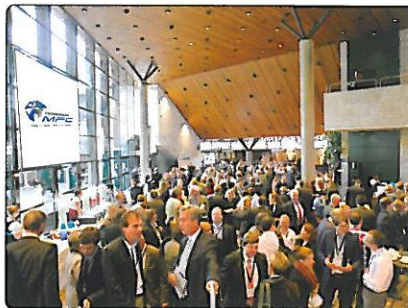
